The Clark County R-1 Board of Education met in regular session on Thursday, December 17, 2019 at 5:30 p.m. in The Board Room located at 427 W. Chestnut St. Kahoka, Missouri. Brad Sprague, Board President, called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Mrs. Parrish and Mrs. Nixon demonstrated Study Island. Study Island is a web-based educational tool geared specifically to help students learn academic standards in a fun and engaging manner. Running Fox has used Study Island in grades 3-5 for about 15 years and is adding K-2 this year. Black Hawk has started to use it for K-5 this year as well. The high school is looking to start using this spring. The study island program is designed to create a user friendly experience for students and teachers, to help relieve some of the test taking anxiety that many students have.

Dr. Kracht shared there is about \$42,000 left over of the bond money, which is enough to cover the block house project..

Dr. Kracht presented two estimates from Mr. Mack and the Building Trades program on the costs for block house project: The rough estimate of the locker room remodel that includes HVAC, is estimated at about \$29,388. The second estimate would include expanding the concession stand, for about \$6,332.

The Board decided they would like to go and look at the concession stand and see what is needed before moving forward with that project. The plan is to tour the facility after the January meeting.

Mr. Harper presented the addition to the MOCAP policy, to add the sentence: "I understand that I agree to provide examples of student work as requested to the CCR-1 School District within 72 hours upon request. "

Dr. Kracht gave an update on upcoming maintenance projects over Christmas break. The maintenance men will be replacing indoor security lights which are on 24/7 with LED lights and then reusing the old lights and ballasts in other areas that need replaced. They will also install motion detecting light switches in the high school and middle school bathrooms and in the high school locker rooms.
