A REMINDER TO OUR GYM AND WEIGHT ROOM PATRONS

The following is the district's policy regarding student and adult/graduate use of the facilities during non-school hours:

- Community members, parents, and graduates must go through the process acquiring a key through central office, paying required deposits, and properly signing up for gym use at the school facility desired.
- **If school aged children are involved in the use of facilities during non-school hours they must be supervised by a parent/legal guardian (only one parent/guardian needs to be present for the entire group) or a school employee at all times.**
- Adults/graduates who have properly acquired their key can use the gym facilities **individually** whenever those facilities are not in use by the school or other groups who have signed up to use the gym. **If graduates/adults want to have a group use the gym; they must sign up and reserve the time through the school facility desired.**
- **Students should only use the weight room facility during non-school hours when they are in the company of a staff member or parent/guardian.**

Failure to follow these guidelines will result in the following outcomes:

- Patrons who allow improper use of their key card to access the facility - e.g. not abiding by the above policies - will have their keycard deactivated. They must contact central office to reactivate their keycard.
 - District administration reserves the right to refuse reactivation of a deactivated keycard based on the circumstances that led to the deactivation.
- Student who are involved in improper use of the facilities or who access the facilities in a way that does not comply with the above policies will receive:
 - **First offense:** 3 hour Saturday detention
 - **Subsequent offenses:** 3 hour Saturday detention up to 3 days OSS

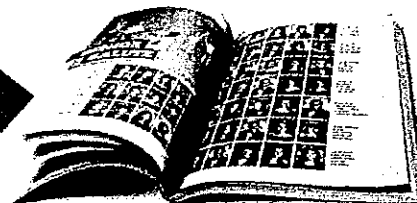

FROM THE LIBRARY

The library is generally open each school day from 7:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. These hours can be extended upon request. Being open before and after school gives students an opportunity to check out or renew books, pay fines, finish an assignment, or have a *quieter* place to work or do research.

If a student wishes to check out or renew a book, borrowed books are due back ten (10) school days from the date of check out. Students are then given an additional twenty (20) school day grace period to return or renew books without receiving a fine. If the book is not returned or renewed during the grace period, the fine is 5¢ per school day from the due date, with a maximum fine of \$1 per overdue book per checkout. A list of students having overdue books and/or fines is posted outside the library each week. A copy of this list is also given to each Communication Arts teacher to post in their classroom, and individual notices are emailed to students each week.








